

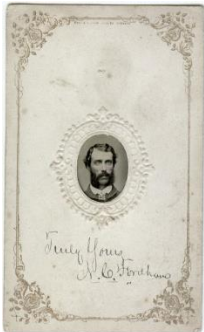


**CDV** — Standing view of Wesley C. Howe of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Massachusetts Cavalry. Originally from Shippensville, Pennsylvania, Howe enlisted as a Sergeant in Company M of the Cal Battalion on March 20, 1863 in San Francisco. Promoted 1<sup>st</sup> Sergeant, then on March 25, 1864 commissioned as a Lieutenant. Captured on September 19, 1864 and spent the winter in Confederate prison camps, paroled February 23, 1865. Howe assembled an album of CDVs after the war which included a number of troopers from Company M. This image was one of four of Howe. #579. **SOLD**



**CDV** – Post war image, ¾ view of Robert Duncan, Co. M 2<sup>nd</sup> Mass Cavalry. Postwar image. Duncan enlisted at the age of 21. A tinsmith by trade, he originated in Andover, Mass. He survived the war.

Duncan's CDV was found in an album assembled by Wesley C. Howe, also of Co. M. The image is sharp and untrimmed. It bears a backmark "O. A. Dolph" of Eerie, Pennsylvania. Collection #580 **\$225**



**Tintype** - portrait view mounted in CDV matte of Nathan C. Fordham, a 28 year old surveyor who enlisted into Company L of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Mass Cavalry in 1863. Fordham served as a private through the war and was a member of the brigade band. He was captured on October 29, 1864 at Cedar Creek, VA. Receiving his parole on February 27, 1865, he rejoined his company on May 23, 1865. On the back, he lists his home as Sag Harbor, Suffolk County, NY. Collection #581 **\$250**



**CDV** – ¾ standing view of Wesley C. Howe, Co. M, 2<sup>nd</sup> Mass Cavalry. He is pictured as a 1<sup>st</sup> Sergeant which dates the image to March 1864 or earlier. One of four images held in Howe's CDV album. The image is sharp and bears a Brady backmark. It has been trimmed on the left and top margins to fit in the CDV album. A Washington D. C. backmark. #582 **SOLD**



**CDV** – Vignette portrait view of Wesley C. Howe, Co. M, 2<sup>nd</sup> Mass Cavalry. He is pictured as a Lieutenant which dates the image to after March 1864. Howe's slouch hat bears the same small crossed sabers embroidered insignia which appears on the slouch hat of Rufus W. Smith. Brady Washington D. C. backmark. Howe's inked initials W. C. H. on face.
