



CDV – UNION SURGEON – LIEUTENANT DAVID D. KENNEDY

CDV – David D. Kennedy who enlisted from Chester County, Pennsylvania as an Assistant Surgeon on August 1, 1862. He was commissioned into Field & Staff of the 57th Pennsylvania Infantry. On December 13 of that year, Kennedy was wounded during the severe fighting at the battle of Fredericksburg.

On January 31, 1863 Kennedy was commissioned into the 133rd Pennsylvania Infantry and was mustered out from that regiment on May 26, 1863 at Harrisburg, PA.

The CDV is sharp with deep contrast. The right border has been trimmed for use in the album of Wesley C. Howe of the 2nd Mass Cavalry. In Howe's hand is inscribed in ink on the face of the image "Dr. Kennedy." Kennedy is pictured with his medical sword and green medical department sash. It bears a Philadelphia backmark.
